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Subsidies and payment options explained

Higher Level Skills Subsidy

The Queensland Government will offset the cost of study for eligible students. You will still need to pay for a portion of your study costs. The amount above is what you will need to pay.

You're eligible for the Higher Level Skills Subsidy if you:

- are 15 years or older and no longer in school,
- live in Queensland full-time,
- must be in paid employment in industry, and
- are an Australian or New Zealand citizen, permanent resident, or temporary resident with the necessary visa or work permits who don't currently have (or are enrolled in) a certificate IV or higher level qualification.

Other restrictions or eligibility criteria may apply.

Payment plans

If you have difficulty paying the full amount of a course upfront, you may be eligible for a payment plan.

Once you have a deposit of 20% of your course fees or \$75 (whichever is greater), you can apply for your interest free student payment plan through the TAFE Queensland South West Customer Service Centre. You will need to complete a Payment Plan Application Form and provide the required documentation (including identification and pay advice/income statements). Cancellation of enrolment does not necessarily cancel the obligation to make all payments under the payment plan. Payment plans are not automatically granted and conditions apply.
